



## IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

**The following information is needed to confirm immunity to both Measles (Rubeola), Mumps and Rubella.**

1. Provide a copy of your MMR immunizations to Volunteer Services. A copy may be faxed or emailed to the Volunteer Coordinator or brought with you at the time of your interview.
2. If you were born after 1957 immunization records must include two vaccines for MMR. If you cannot provide a copy of a two shot immunization to MMR and need a blood draw please let Volunteer Services know. A free blood draw will be provided for you on the day of your orientation session. No appointment is necessary, but please bring a photo ID with you.
3. If you were born before 1957 immunization records must include only one vaccination for Measles (Rubeola) and Rubella, or provide proof of Measles (Rubeola) and Rubella diagnosis. If you cannot provide a copy of a MMR immunization or proof of diagnosis, please arrange a no cost titer (blood draw) with Volunteer Services at the time of your interview.
4. If your titer results are negative for MMR immunity, please speak with Volunteer Services. If you cannot receive an MMR booster through your primary physician, Employee Health Services will provide the vaccine. We cannot offer reimbursement for a vaccination, so please speak with Volunteer Services if the cost of this booster will be prohibitive.
