

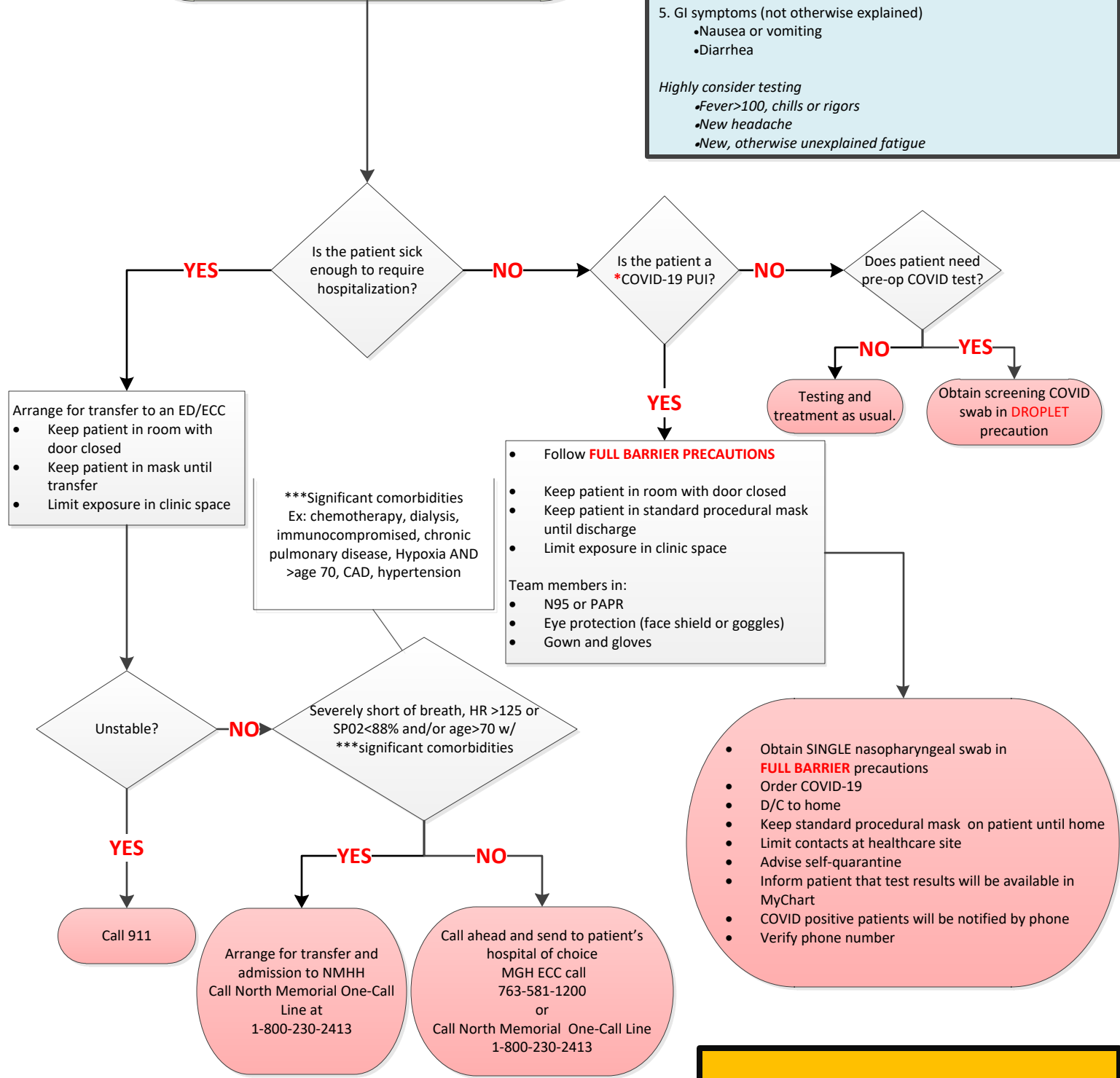
COVID-19 Diagnostic Algorithm

Outpatient and Urgent Care

Effective starting 1/3/2023

- *COVID-19 Person Under Investigation (PUI) Criteria – person has one or more of the following symptoms:**
- Upper / Lower respiratory symptoms
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Patient reports contact with someone who was confirmed or suspected to have COVID-19 within the last 10 days
 - Imaging (CXR or CT chest) consistent with COVID-19 infection
 - GI symptoms (not otherwise explained)
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- Highly consider testing*
- Fever >100, chills or rigors
 - New headache
 - New, otherwise unexplained fatigue

- Patient presents for evaluation
- Mask patient per masking guideline
- Mask team members per universal masking and eye protection guidelines



***Significant comorbidities
Ex: chemotherapy, dialysis, immunocompromised, chronic pulmonary disease, Hypoxia AND >age 70, CAD, hypertension
